

## An arrangement has:

- 1. a beginning, a middle and an end.
- 2. suits the mood that you are trying to create
- 3. has variety and suprises
- 4. holds together musically.

## Muscial devices to use in an arrangement

- 1. reharmonization, pedal points
- 2. vamps, interludes, verses
- 3. rhythmic figure and "kicks" or "stops."
- 4. changes in rhytmnic feel (in 2 or in 4, swing to bossa, etc.)
- 5. tempo changes (rubato to ballad tempo to ritards, etc.)
- 6. changes in key signature, modulations.
- 7. dymanics, soft and loud passages
- 8. solo sections, breakout band sections (just bass and voice or piano and voice)

## Questions to ask yourself

- 1. what is the instrumentation I'll be using?
- 2. what tempo will I play at and what is the "groove?"
- 3. what overall mood am I trying to create:
- . dreamy, energetic, buoyant, swingy, soothing, danceable, playful?
- 4. what is the form of the tune including solo sections, etc.
- 5. what is my introduction and how does it lead me into the song and set up the mood I want to create?
- 6. how will we create variety in the song?
- 7. what is the ending?
